Re Remembrance - it feels like a celebration of the Town Council, the Duke and local MP. Why are the Cubs and Brownies centre stage?

Where is the space for all of the serving personnel and veterans local to Arundel? They are dotted about, in the crowd. They should have a dedicated space for them to stand. They should be acknowledged as part of the ceremony.

When you remove the bollards in River road you completely change the living environment for those on that road. I acknowledge and support the removal for the summer festival and the Christmas festival, but strongly oppose the general opening for any other event. I also question the benefit to the residents of the central town of any more events. Many actual shopkeepers (as opposed to the stalls brought in) have said they do not benefit, the visitors do not purchase much and indeed the volume of theft goes up. For the residents of central Arundel we are just overrun by hoards of people and cars. There is no benefit to the residents at all. If this is the case and indeed the only businesses to profit are the restaurants (and there is no evidence available to support a substantial business increase) I do not believe the number of events should be increased. I strongly believe the Town Council is elected to act in the interest of the residents and there is a body of feeling that the residents take second place to the commercial side of the town.

I think the Arundel Festival has always been a very well organised and thoroughy enjoyable event. It is clearly enjoyed very much by all visitors and taken overall is a joy to experience. I would add as a regular visitor to Arundel, the idea of any disgruntled trader or traders being rude to or bullying any members of the organising team of the festival is completely unwarranted and should not be tolerated whatsoever.

The recent event in the High Street on Sunday 15th Sept was well attended but shambolic in safety terms - there were cars and stands placed seemingly randomly with no consideration to pathways through for people or in the worst case an ambulance or fire engine (although they were there!). It was promoted as supporting local businesses, but some were closed and many had their frontages blocked by stalls or cars. Were any of the stalls or cars actually Arundel residents/businesses? The hospitality businesses appeared to be doing very well - but I wonder how the Swan's Sunday Lunch trade was affected by a large number of scooters outside, LG cafe didn't open? The scooters were interesting but how much did they contribute to the businesses trade? There was nothing for children, despite being advertised as having children's activities. The whole atmosphere was rather like s car boot sale with some live music - is this what Arundel is aiming for? I think most residents want a bit of 'class and style' in what, after all is meant to be the 'Jewel in the Crown' in Arun District.
